The Club was founded in 1947 in order to provide facilities for the young people brought over by the Central British Fund to this country from the Concentration Camps, after having been liberated at the end of the war by Allied Armies. Its first premises were in the Jewish Refugees' hostel in Belsize Park and its name "Primrose" originated from its vicinity to Primrose Hill.

From its outset the Club proved a success under the wise guidance of an experienced leader, and before long its membership was increased, first by the inclusion of other former refugees and children of refugees, and later by the admission of other young people in the neighbourhood. The Club became affiliated to the Association for Jewish Youth and to the London Federation of Boys' Clubs, and to the Hampstead Council of Youth. Very soon it was taking part in athletic competitions in which it enjoyed some noteworthy achievements. Both in 1947 and 1949 it ended top of the A.J.Y. Football League (under 18), and in the latter year also won the A.J.Y. Senior Swimming Cup as well as heading the Hampstead Table Tennis League. In addition, it won the London Federation of Boys' Clubs Chess Cup in 1948.

In 1949, when the membership had increased to over 300, the Club suddenly had to vacate its premises owing to the termination of the lease.



But although numbers naturally tended to reduce, members were determined not to let their Club die and continued to meet weekly in a local Church Hall and at the local gymnasium. During the last year the Club has won the Junior Division of the London Basketball League and has been promoted to the Second Division. It also tied for the AJ.Y. Senior Athletics Shield and won the A.J.Y. Men's and Women's swimming Cups. Its activities have been, however, not confined merely to sports; it tied for fiirst place in an A.J.Y. Variety Competition, whilst one of its members recently won four first class certificates at the A.J.Y. Arts and Crafts competition. It is pleasing to record that a member of the Primrose Club is the present Chairman of the Members' Council of the A.J.Y.

Meanwhile a number of well-wishers were looking round for other premises and eventually, in 1951, a suitable house at 523 Finchley Road was bought, with the aid of a grant from the Central British Fund and a loan from the Jewish Youth Fund. After long delay a licence was eventually obtained for the necessary repairs and the most essential work is now in hand. A new governing council has been formed, including local residents and persons who are closely connected with the C.B.F. A resident youth leader and his wife, who will supervise the girls' side of the Club, have been engaged.

The need for a Jewish Youth Club in North West London is very great. It is intended to divide the members into two groups, the first for those from 14 to 19 and the second for those over 19 and up to 25. The Club will provide facilities for cultural as well as athletic activities and keen local interest is already being evinced in its development.

Although the necessary finances have been secured for the building, funds will be required for additional equipment and for current expenditure.


